ABOUT THE HELPING HANDS MINI WALK FOR THE HOMELESS

HOW DOES HOMELESSNESS AFFECT OUR COMMUNITY?

Nearly 12,000 people in the Washington DC area were homeless last year. The number of homeless is on the rise, and in Montgomery County the number of homeless students has increased significantly. Montgomery County is also experiencing the highest number of families in need of support.

HOW DOES STEPPING STONES SHELTER HELP THE HOMELESS?

Stepping Stones Shelter has been a homeless shelter for children and families located right in our neighborhood. **Stepping Stones Shelter** is in the unique position of bringing the entire family to the shelter. This ensures the family will stay in tact, and they help get the parents back on their feet and in their own home. They have been supporting local families for over 20 years.
